## Word Roots:

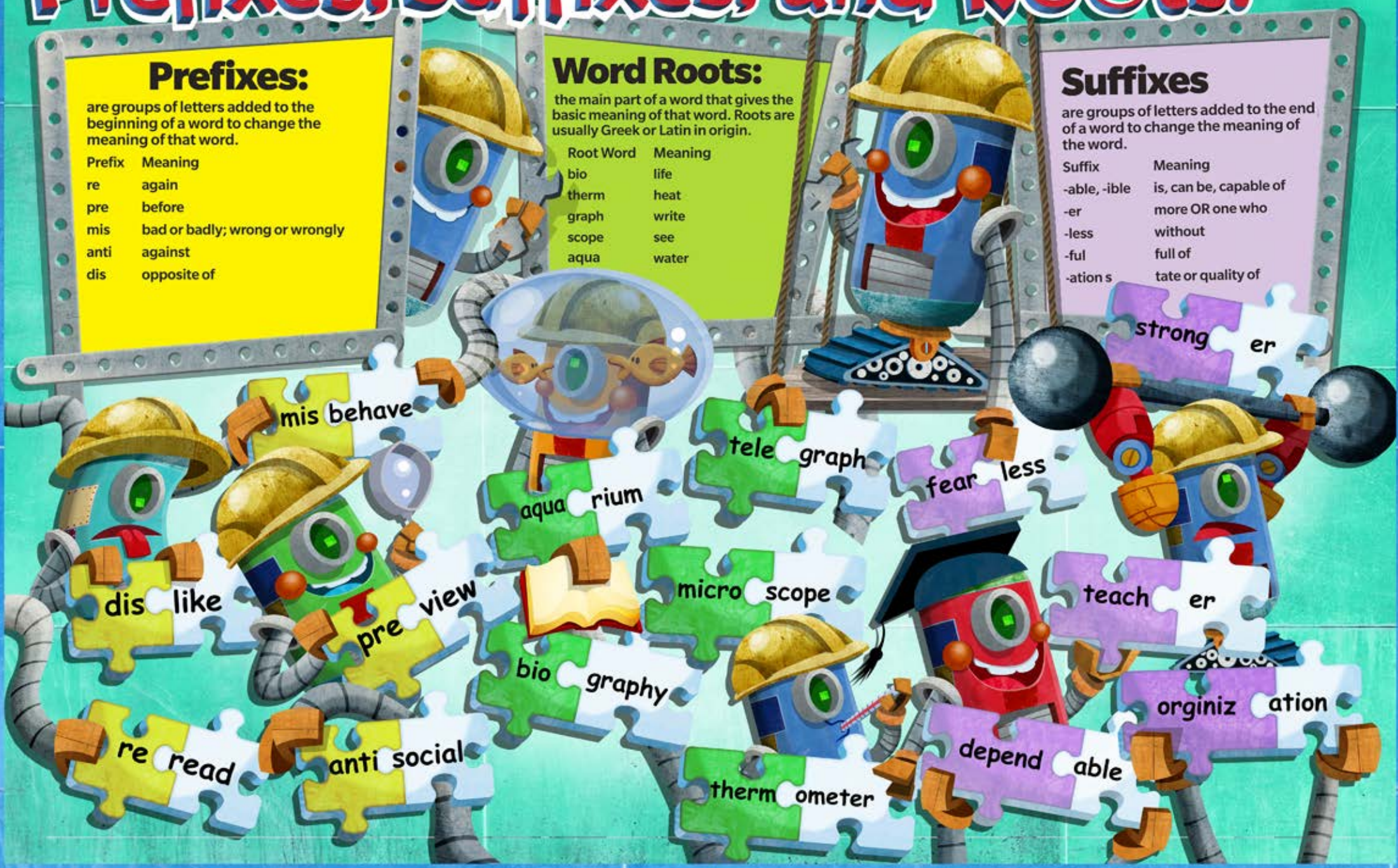
the main part of a word that gives the basic meaning of that word. Roots are usually Greek or Latin in origin.
